

Code of Professional Conduct Committee (CPCC)

Purpose:

To assist the Board of Directors in reviewing and revising the Code of Professional Conduct.

Objectives:

To identify areas that need to be addressed due to changes in the profession.

Goals:

1. To be a resource to the Board of Directors and members.
2. To review and compare other codes to the current RID Code.

Qualifications:

1. Members must be voting members in good standing (member of an Affiliate Chapter and a National Certified or Associate member).
2. Members must be willing to attend conference calls and face-to-face meetings as scheduled.
3. Members must commit to attend the national conference and pre-conference meetings of the committee.
4. Members must work cooperatively with other committee members and chair, the National Office committee coordinator and the board liaison.
5. Members must be willing to serve two-year terms commencing at the end of a national conference and facilitate transitions for new committee members as needed.
6. Members must be accessible to the National Office staff and the committee chair.
7. Members must have e-mail access and respond in a timely manner as the bulk of committee work is done via e-mail.
