C2009.01	To have the <i>Policies & Procedures Manual</i> and the <i>Articles of Incorporation</i> of the National Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf published online within 90 days of the end of the 2009 Biennial Conference and for the documents and any subsequent changes to be accessible on a permanent basis to all members after logging in to their RID account.	Already implemented. No further action necessary.
C 2009.02	<p>To amend the RID Bylaws ARTICLE IV Section 2. by adding language in the body of Section 2 and then A and B containing the following language:</p> <p>Article IV. DIRECTORS</p> <p>Section 2. — Powers and Limitations: All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of the Board of Directors except as limited by Sections A and B below. Unless so authorized by the Board of Directors, no officer, agent, or employee shall have any power or authority to bind the corporation by any contract or engagement or to pledge its credit or to render it liable monetarily for any purpose or in any amount. All charges, responsibilities and membership directives shall persist until fulfilled regardless of any changes to the makeup of the Board of Directors. Specific powers and limitations are defined in the Policies and Procedures Manual and are in accordance with the RID's Articles of Incorporation.</p> <p>A. The Board may add certificates to or add or change categories for membership in RID only with prior approval of 2/3 of the eligible membership voting on the issue.</p> <p>B. The Board may enter into a contract that changes, adds to, or amends certification or membership status only with prior approval of 2/3 of the eligible membership voting on the issue.</p>	Revised version of Bylaws placed on Web site. No further action necessary.
C2009.03	RID conduct a formal investigation on remote meeting access (including voting processes) to ensure maximum member input and report back to the membership for a vote by July 1, 2010, and have a system in place for the 2011 Conference. C2009.04	The board of directors investigate the feasibility of ensuring dual membership in the national organization and at least one state affiliate chapter through a combined payment option as the new standard of membership in RID and offer it to the members for a vote. C2007.04	<i>That RID develop a set of guidelines for including for membership and/or conferring of certified status, individuals who hold credentials from any entity other than RID; that these guidelines be approved by majority vote of the certified membership of RID; and that RID wait until the implementation of these guidelines prior to entering into further discussions, agreements, contracts or in any way incorporating non-RID/NAD certificates into our organization.</i>	This motion is superceded by C2009.02, which changes the RID Bylaws in this area. This item will be retired. Guidelines to comply with revised Bylaws and incorporate the intent of this motion completed. No further action necessary.
